


Cloudy Day Quilt Sampler

16 inch Block Sampler
Finished Quilt Size - 72 1/2 x 72 1/2 inches

Basic Instructions

1. Read all instructions before beginning.
2. All seam allowances are a scant 1/4 inch. A scant is a 1/4 inch seam that includes the width of your needle/thread. It is important to use a scant 1/4 inch seam so all your blocks line up correctly. **How to test your scant 1/4 inch seam:** Take three 2 1/2 x 4 inch strips. With right sides of fabric together, sew the three strips together as shown to the right. The center strip will measure 2 inches wide finished, if you are sewing an accurate scant 1/4 inch seam. 
3. Pattern assumes most width of fabrics are 42 inches. If you like to prewash your fabric, you will want to purchase 1/4 yard more fabric to account for shrinkage. When you wash cotton fabric it shrinks and may fray on the ends.
4. When the pattern refers to 'nest your seams', you will want to make sure one seam is pressed to the left and the other to the right. This will make it so your seams line up like a puzzle.
5. Basic sewing, piecing and quilting knowledge needed.

Fabric Needed

Finished Throw size: 72 1/2 x 72 1/2 inches

Color A (Navy): 2/3 yard total

For Blocks: 10 inches

Cornerstones: 12 1/2 inches

Color B (Blue): 3/4 yard

Color C (Lime Green): 1 yard

Color D (Dark Green): 1/2 yard

Color E (Silver): 4 1/4 total

Background in blocks: 1 3/4 yards

Sashing and Corner stones: 2 1/2 yards

Color F - Binding: 2/3 yard

Color G - Backing: 4 1/2 yards



Throughout the pattern, arrows will show what direction to press the seams.

For the cover photo quilt, I used all Kona Solids

A: Storm

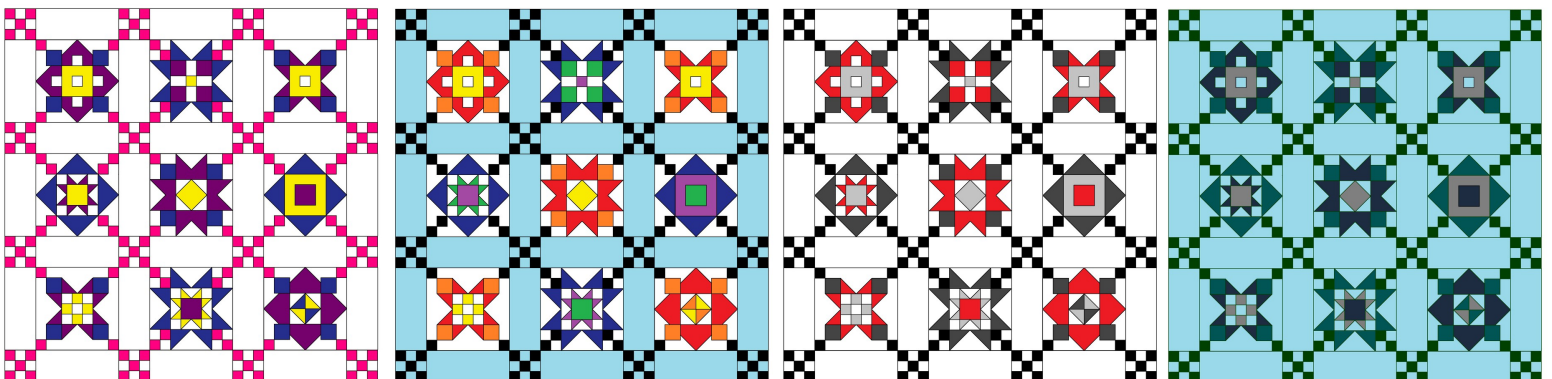
B: Jamaica

D: Jungle

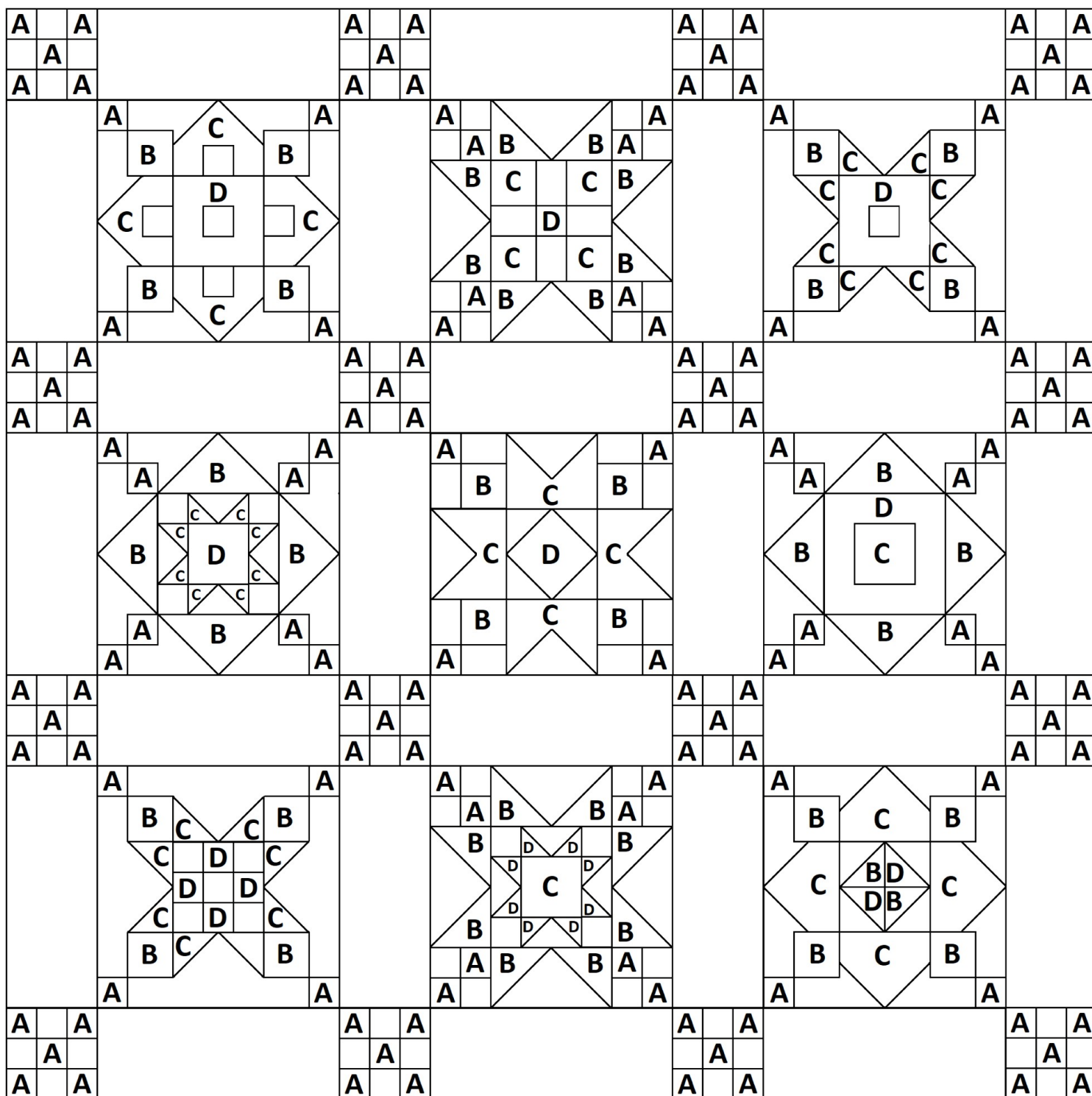
